

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

When used as directed, this product is formulated to disinfect hard, nonporous, nonmetal, environmental surfaces: floors, walls, metal surfaces, stainless steel surfaces, glazed porcelain, glazed ceramic tile, plastic surfaces, vinyl, chrome, bathtubs, shower stalls, shower doors, bathtubs, toilets, bathroom fixtures, kitchens, countertops, sinks, exteriors of microwaves, refrigerators, stoves, and other kitchen appliances, stoves, automobile interiors, cabinets, tables, chairs, desks, dining room surfaces, doorknobs, garbage cans and telephones, large inflatable non-porous plastic, rubber, advertising structures; animals, promotional items, moonwalks, slides, obstacle course play equipment, exercise equipment, exercise mats, wrestling mats.

Control Mold and Mildew on Large, Inflatable, Non-Porous Plastic and Rubber Structures (animals, promotional items, moonwalks, slides, obstacle course play equipment, exercise equipment, and wrestling mats): Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Saturate surfaces with a use-solution of 8 ounces of this product per 4 gallons of water for a period of 10 minutes. Ventilate buildings and other closed spaces. Do not use equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set, or dried.

Leave all treated surfaces exposed to disinfectant solution wet for 10 minutes or more. Rinse with potable water before reuse. Then allow to air dry. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required.
